Definition of Parental responsibility.

"Parental responsibility" means all the rights, duties, powers, responsibilities and authority which by law a parent of a child has in relation to the child and his property.

The mother of a child always has PR and the father of the child would have PR if he is/has been married to the mother, has entered into a PR agreement with the mother, has a court order giving him PR or his name is on the birth certificate if the child is born after December 2003. There may also be cases where a child is subject to a Residence Order or a Special Guardianship Order and in those circumstances the person in whose favour the order has been made would have PR. If a child is subject to a Care Order then the Local Authority would have PR.

"A contact order" means an order requiring the person with whom a child lives, or is to live, to allow the child to visit or stay with the person named in the order, or for that person and the child otherwise to have contact with each other;

There may be some people who do not have PR eg grandparents but who have a court order saying that they should have contact with the child. There could also be people like fathers who have PR and also a contact order."
